Your gynaecologist has referred you to the x-ray department for an examination to image the womb and fallopian tubes.

The examination is called an ***hysterosalpingogram (HSG)***

In order for the examination to be booked, you will need to contact the x-ray department on the **first day of your period**. This will allow us to book you an appointment within 10 days of your menstrual cycle.

It will take approximately two weeks for your referral to be received and processed. **You should have undergone a Chlamydia screening within 6 months before undergoing the hysterosalpingography as this reduce the risk of pelvic infection that may develop after the test.** You should receive a letter confirming that you are on the waiting list and information about the procedure.

If you have not received this information within 4 wks of the referral, please contact the above numbers.

If you do not attempt to make an appointment within 2 months of your initial letter, your referral will be cancelled and returned to your gynaecologist.

If your periods are irregular or absent, then please advise the x-ray department of this and an appointment can be scheduled for an appropriate date.
